Answer: They know that as soon as they do, one of their adult kids will want to store stuff there.

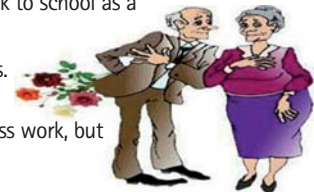
Question: What do retirees call a long lunch?
